10. Persecuted Church:

CAMERON- Boko Haram raids on Christian-majority villages along the northwestern border with Nigeria have specifically targeted churches and Christian activity. In a typical attack, Christians are killed or displaced, churches are burned and homes are destroyed. Several Christian villages have been abandoned completely after recurring attacks, which have included killings, kidnappings, and the burning of houses, schools and churches. Cameroon is a majority-Christian country, including 52 percent Christians and 24 percent Muslims.

- Pray that Christians in Cameroon will love one another so Christ will be glorified.
- Pray for Christians rebuilding their livelihood after Boko Haram attacks.
- Pray for Christians among the Hdi tribe whose villages in the north are routinely attacked.
