Persecuted Church: Russia - Christians in Russia who are not part of the Russian Orthodox Church are legally restricted in several activities of their faith, especially evangelism. A law characterizes Christians and churches outside the Russian Orthodox Church as religious extremists, criminalizing the speech and activities of Russian Christians who faithfully witness for Christ. In addition to these restrictions, churches have been violently attacked, pastors have been attacked and abducted, and some pastors have been killed. Persecution has been used as a tactic to isolate Christians who are opposed to Putin and his regime. Some Christians with connections to the West have been targeted for persecution, while Russian Christians who do not oppose the regime still meet openly in their churches.

- Pray that Christians worshipping outside the Russian Orthodox Church will boldly witness.
- Pray that Christians will have a vision to reach the lost.
- Pray that the body of Christ will be the light of the world (Matt. 5:14)
- Pray for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit and a great turning to Christ in this region.
- Pray that many will have an insatiable hunger for God's Word. persecution.com
