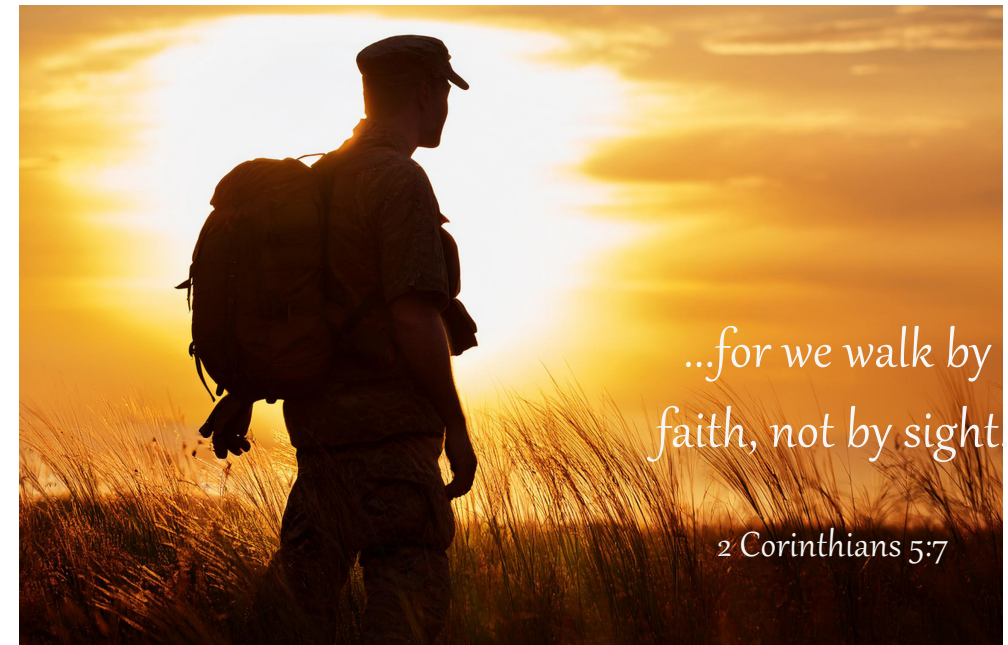

## Call to Prayer

**Persecuted Church:** Mauritania - has been staunchly Islamic for more than 1,000 years and struggles with poverty and corruption. Located on Africa's western coast, Mauritania has strong connections and cultural similarities to its North African neighbors. Slavery still exists within tribal groups, with Christians commonly subservient to the majority-Moor people groups. There are currently no national churches in Mauritania and fewer than 150 known believers. In 2009, an American missionary was killed in Mauritania, and many mission agencies subsequently withdrew their workers from the country. Some Christian workers, however, are starting to return. Security risks for both national Christians and foreign missionaries remain obstacles to reaching Muslims with the gospel. [persecution.com](http://persecution.com)

- Pray that Christians will persevere and retain their eternal hope in Christ.
- Pray that those imprisoned for their faith will be bold witnesses for Christ.
- Pray that Christians who worship in secret will find Christian fellowship.
- Pray that Christians will have access to God's Word, despite government restrictions.
- Pray for the repeal of apostasy laws, which carry the death penalty for former Muslims.
